


Make a Logo in Inkscape



You'll need:

- A computer
- Inkscape Design Software

Instructions:

1. Open Inkscape on your computer. First we will select the TEXT icon in the right toolbar and drag to create a text box on our page. Type "Bob's Boxing Gym" and use the top toolbar to select a font and center-align your text.
2. Select the CIRCLE tool in the left toolbar and drag to create an oval large enough to fit your text inside. Place it over your text.
3. With your oval selected, click on the FILL box in the bottom left to open the Fill & Stroke window. Select No Fill, and a Solid Stroke. Color the stroke red, and adjust your stroke width in the Stroke Style tab.
4. Select your text. Use the SWATCHES on the bottom to color it blue.
5. Select the STAR tool in the right toolbar and drag to create a small star on the left of your text. Using the Fill & Stroke window, give it a solid red fill, and no stroke.
6. Right-click on your star and click DUPLICATE in the drop-down menu. Drag your new star to the other side of your text.
7. Duplicate one of your stars again and move it to the side slightly, then hold CTRL+Shift while dragging the corner point to make it slightly smaller. Duplicate the smaller star and drag the copy to the opposite side of your design.
8. Hold SHIFT and drag a selection box around all of your objects, then hold shift and deselect the oval outline. In the OBJECT drop-down menu at the top, find and select the ALIGN & DISTRIBUTE option. This will open up a new window.
9. Find the "Make Horizontal Gaps Between Objects Equal" option in the Distribute section and select. Right-click on your object selection and click GROUP.
10. Hold SHIFT and re-select the oval as well. ALIGN the oval and the group with the center horizontally and center vertically options.
11. Go to File>Save As to save your project, or Export as a PNG.
