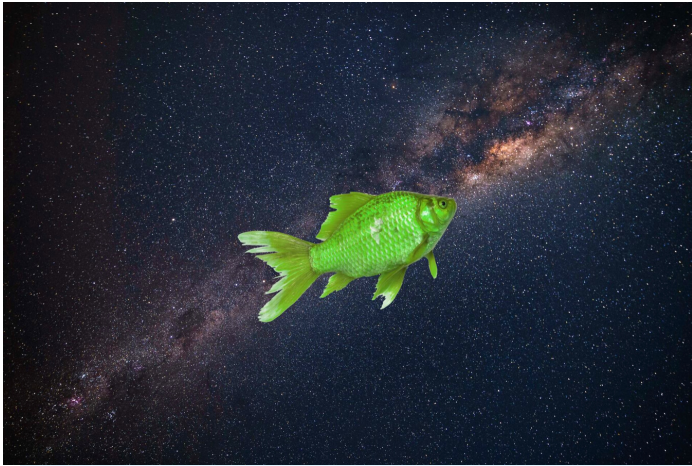


# Edit photos in Photopea.com



## You'll need:

- A computer
- Internet access

## Instructions:

1. Go to [www.photopea.com](http://www.photopea.com)
2. Select FILE> OPEN and open a picture of a goldfish.
3. Select the ERASER tool from the left toolbar and erase the background around your fish. Adjust the SIZE of your eraser in the upper left corner.
4. Press and hold CTRL+Z to undo mistakes.
5. Select and hold the 3rd icon down on the left toolbar. the MAGIC WAND tool should be visible. Select and click on the remaining background. Press the DELETE key to remove the selected areas. Adjust the TOLERANCE bar if needed to change the tool's sensitivity.
6. In the LAYERS panel, click the NEW LAYER button. Then click and drag this layer under your fish layer.
7. Select the BRUSH tool on the left toolbar. Then click on the SWATCH icon in the bottom left to choose a bright color in COLOR PICKER.
8. Color the entire area with your brush. This will reveal any background spots you missed. Select your fish layer, and use the eraser to clean up any leftover background. Delete the color layer when you're done.
9. Save the fish as a PNG.
10. Go to FILE> OPEN and open a picture of outer space.
11. Go to FILE> OPEN & PLACE and select the PNG of the fish you created.
12. Use the TRANSFORM CONTROLS to scale, rotate, and move the fish.
13. Go to IMAGE> ADJUSTMENTS> HUE & SATURATION. In the new window, slide the hue, saturation, and lightness to change the color of the fish.
14. Go to FILE> EXPORT AS> JPG to save your final image.
