

Tissue Paper Marigolds



You'll need:

- Yellow and Orange Tissue Paper
- Pipe Cleaner or Thin Wire
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Take 1 sheet of tissue paper and cut it in half.
2. Cut each piece in half again, horizontally.
3. Cut each piece in half again, this time vertically. You should have 8 rectangles of tissue paper.
4. Take 4 of your pieces and stack them together. Fold on the short edge, accordion style.
5. Wrap a pipe cleaner around the center of the compressed paper. This will be the stem.
6. On each edge of your folded paper, cut off a rounded edge to give a petal-like shape.
7. Fan out the folded paper around the pipe cleaner, then carefully separate and fluff each layer of tissue paper towards the center of your flower.
